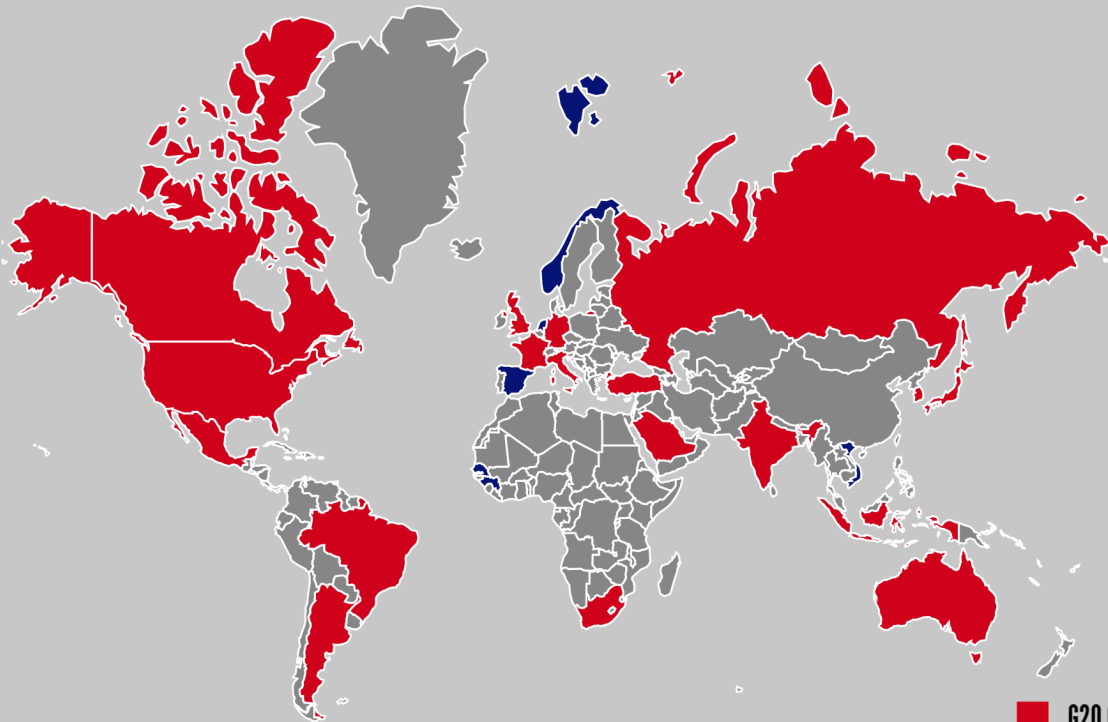
WHAT IS THE G20?
